4. Matters arising from the minutes of the meeting held 16 January 2023

Defibrillator

The clerk confirmed that the door mechanism had now been attended to and was working properly. The clerk had written to Mr & Mrs Pugh Nottingham House who had now arranged for the gutterin causing the overflow of water into the kiosk to be repaired. This matter can now be closed.

Fly Tipping – Rose Cottage

Bins were now in situ, but resolved to monitor the position and report to clerk if problem re occurs.

Llanbadarn Fawr Horticultural Show – The clerk had contacted the National Library of Wales and Ceredigion Museum who had both declined to store the cups and trophies. Cllr Caroline Hodges suggested possibly donating the cups, in which case they may be more interested in the artifacts. Cllr Gareth Davies to check value of said items. Clerk asked to make enquiries with Mid Wales Storage to establish costs.

The floor uplights near the war memorial were still not working. Clerk to contact Tom Edwards again asking him to attend to them as quickly as possible.

Maes Mawr Estate

Cllr Gareth Davies said that there was nothing further to currently report regarding the traffic issues in the area.

Benches and Notice Board – The clerk had spoken to Both Geraint Evans and Aled Jones in relation to the collection and re-installment of the various benches in the village. Cllrs D Greaney and Ben Davies had undertaken an audit of what exactly was required. Aled Jones had submitted a quotation of £450 for this work which was accepted. Clerk to arrange that Aled carries out the work at his earliest convenience. Aled had also collected the Noticeboard from Tom Edwards.

Brynheidol Estate – There was no further update available in relation to parking on the estate. It was known that there had been a fire on the estate recently, with the Fire Service having attended without obstruction.
